
There's nothing like seeing the GNRS in person. There are really some wild things to see. And don't forget about the food court area at lunch time. 2012 is right around the corner! Be there!

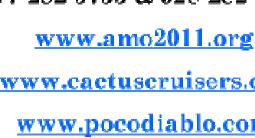
