Happy New Year and welcome to 2011! This year is the 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the beginning of SoCalAMX. Back in 2001 I thought to myself there must be many more AMX'ers out there besides myself. So in 2001 I started this group by creating a web site called SoCalAMX hoping to draw as many people together as possible to share our common interest of AMX's.

The first person I met was Dave Chick and his white 68 AMX. The number of people joining us was small at first but grew over the years. Today we have a solid core of about 10 people who get together frequently at car shows, although we would really like to drastically increase the numbers in the future. We have also had four car shows, and this year we're beginning to plan our fifth edition of our yearly gathering.

All though the focus of SoCalAMX back in 2001 was the 68-70 AMX, immediately Javelins started showing up along the AMX's and were warmly welcomed. Over the years many other AMCs have joined us from time to time, including Ramblers, Gremlins and Pacers, a Rebel and a SC/Rambler now, and we've almost become an AMC club rather than exclusively an AMX club. It's possible in the future that our group's name can change to something different to reflect our growing diversity of AMC models. Just let it be said that all AMCs and Ramblers are welcome to join us anytime we meet and get together!

This is almost sounding like a "State of the Club" speech, eh? I just want to say this isn't my club—it's our club and we need more of the people who sit on the side and read the newsletters without participating, to take action and join us at least once in a while. That's it for now; see you at the next show!




