

SoCalAMX Car Show In May

This year's 8th annual "West Coast All AMC Car Show," hosted by SoCalAMX, is still on! Due to circumstances beyond anyone's control, this year the NHRA Museum was not able to host our show like they have in the past.

The show will still be on the same planned date of Saturday, May 31st, and the hours will remain from 10am to about 3pm.

One of our club members, Tom Macomber, stepped forward and offered the availability of his hobby shop's parking lot, and talked the business owner next door into the same, doubling the number of available parking spaces, so we could still hold our event.

By the way, the new address is listed on the updated Car Show flyer and on the web site but here it is again. Pegasus Hobbies Store, <u>5505</u> Moreno St, Montclair, CA 91763.

This is going to work out very well because the original date of May 31st will not have to be changed, and this new location is just minutes away from the NHRA Museum, allowing anyone who still shows up at the old location, enough time to zip over to the new address.




After the show around 4pm there will be a short cruise up the street to a joint called "The Hat," which has some of the best junk food around like Pastrami sandwiches, and Chili fries!

on! The car has been hanging in the air for over 12 months while the bottom was stripped of all parts, cleaned, painted, and all suspension parts cleaned, painted and reinstalled. Finally in early March it was

time to put the car back on the ground so we could move onto the next step.

Two weeks ago John S. Allen T., and myself, used an engine hoist to one-at -a-time, lower the front end, then rear, back onto the ground. For good measure because there were still several hours of daylight left in the day we were able to put the recently rebuilt engine back in the car, and also hook up the transmission.

The following week Allen was able to hook up most of the engine components and wiring. The engine will be running within a month-maybe! Next we plan to install all of the interior, then lastly do the final block sanding and painting of the body.


ECCUCE GLUCE
