MAY 22 AMC CAR SHOW

Keep your calendars open for May 22 this year. The 4th Annual SoCalAMX car show is only 9 weeks away as of the middle of the month of March. Entries have already arrived which help in the planning of the event. Send yours in when possible. There will be a complementary souvenir handout in everyone's registration packet with a list of entrants and their cars—who have preregistered. The list of trophies to be awarded is slightly changed from 2009. Last year we were overwhelmed with AMX's (a good thing!) and only had 3 trophies for 26 cars, where as in the AMC and Rambler classes there were 3 trophies for 10 cars in each class. So to more fairly share the number of trophies between cars the list below has been developed. The AMX class is being split into two classes, Stock and Modified. The 68-70 Javelins, and 71-74 Javelins are being grouped together; and then split into Stock and Modified. Here is the list of awards for the show.

1st—3rd Place Rambler/Nash/Hudson


At the show we have 8-Track Carl lined up to play music on his DJ system. He once owned a 68 Rouge years ago which he says he wishes he still had.
