# M.A.T.O.

MATO or Midnight at the Oasis as it is called. This unique car show is held in Yuma, AZ each year in the early part of March. Perfect time for the show before it heats up there. The temps are usually in the low to mid 80's with clear skies, and this year was no different.

The layout of this complex is 4 baseball diamonds together where the San Diego Padres once had their spring training. Now once a year it's a big car show, with about 800 cars all managing to park on the grass. They have one meal a day for the show entrants, bar-b-q chicken and tri-tip, a concert Friday and Saturday nights. This show is so big it requires the sheriff department to handle traffic control in and out of the park and to be a show of force during the day.

But this year our ring leader Randy Kirby who normally organizes everybody from our club to go, himself couldn't make it, and Dale Crum and his parents couldn't make it as well.

I asked a longtime friend Mike to join me for the trip. He drives double trailers behind his Ford truck (camper and boat) and I don't know anyone I trust more driving my truck and trailer. It's nice to kick back in the right seat for a change.
