For the Friday event of the weekend we have made reservations for our group to visit the Nethercutt Collection Car Museum in the city of Sylmar, close to where the 5, 405, 118, 210, and 170 Freeways meet together. The museum is split into two buildings, one is open each day to the public, and the other is available by tour only, which is the one we will be seeing. The private tour will include very special and rare cars, clocks and watches, and a room of fascinating music machines, which will be demonstrated—live! ### **Enderle Center Car Show**


The Enderle Center in Tustin has a morning car cruise every first and last Sunday of each month. SoCalAMX has attended a few of these shows in the past but not so recently.
